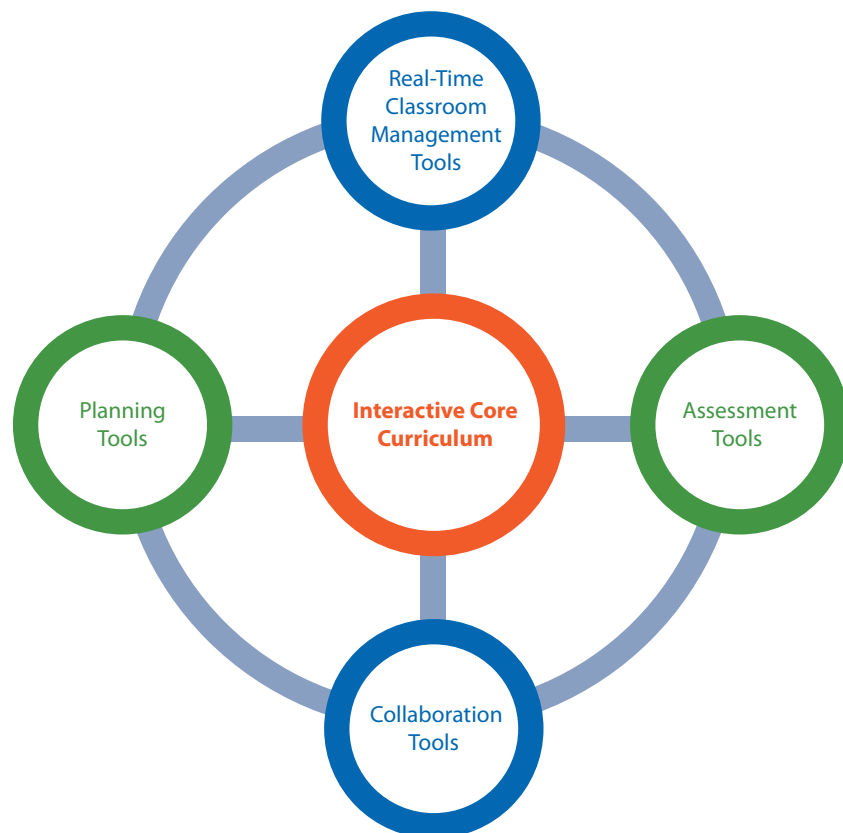

Time To Know provides robust summative and formative assessment and reporting.

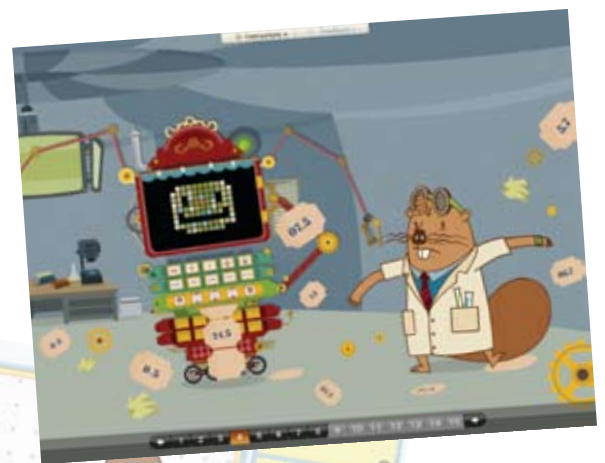
Because Time To Know records and analyzes every action by every student during the learning process, teachers enjoy a unique, in-depth view of student progress, even before any tests are given.

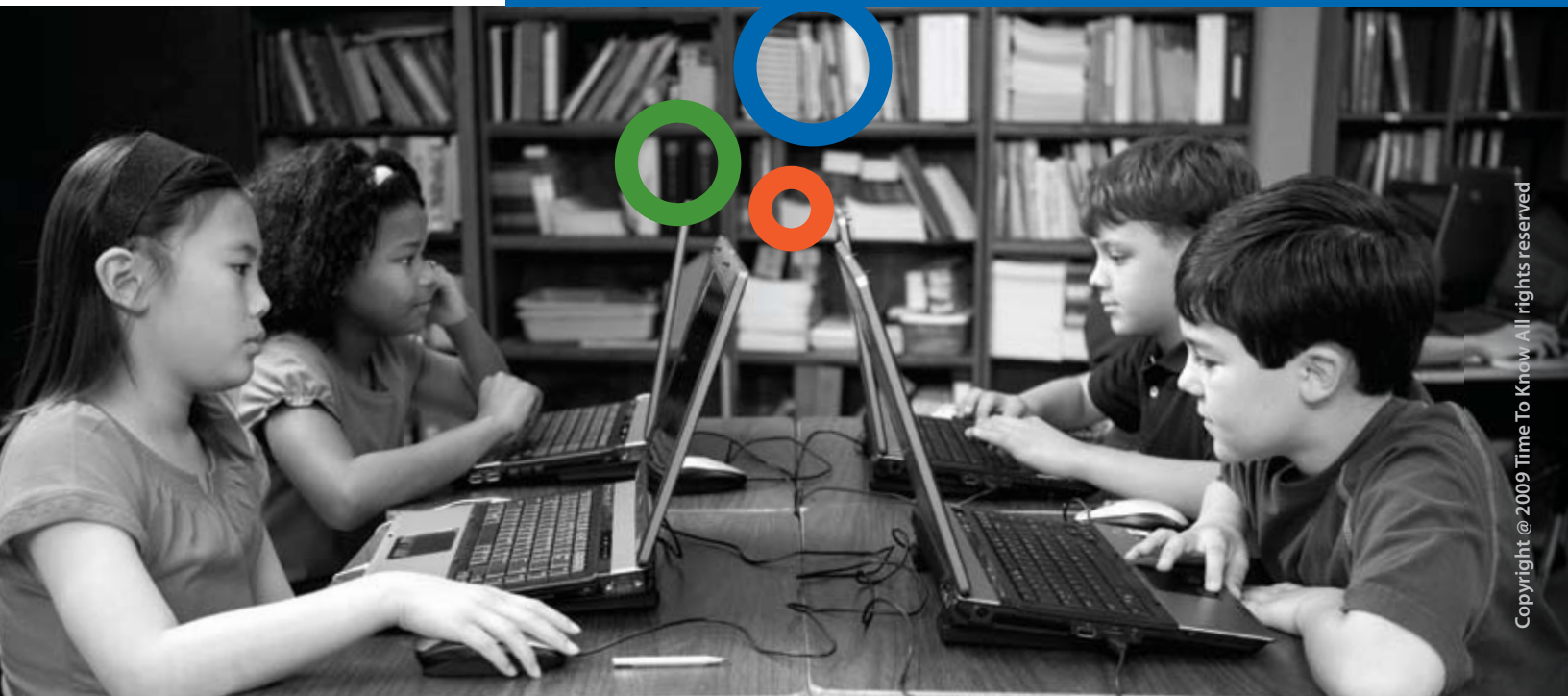
